- ✓ Can obtain at least 7 staff members to commit to attending

There are 3 types of training series that you can choose to schedule at your location free of charge:

- 1. PITC Series- 5 classes at 3 hours each on Program for Infant Toddler Care Relationship-based care practices
- 2. **Birth To Three Series** 6 classes at 2 hours each on each of the 5 Domains of Development
- 3. **Health and Safety Series** $\underline{4}$ classes at $\underline{2}$ hours each on Tummy Time, Outdoor play, Moving and Learning, and Mealtimes

Effective October 1, 2016 all child care PROVIDERS <u>must be ELIGIBLE</u> to receive child care subsidies. PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY requires at least 10 hours of DFD Approved Health & Safety Training as well as Pediatric First Aid & CPR Training.
