- ✓ Can accommodate adult seating and tables in a conducive learning environment (preferably an auditorium, or multi-purpose room, for example)
- ✓ Have ample parking spaces available
- ✓ Can obtain at least 7 staff members to commit to attending

There are 3 types of training series that you can choose to schedule at your location *free of charge*:

1. **PITC Series**- 5 classes at 3 hours each on [Program for Infant Toddler Care](#) Relationship-based care practices
2. **Birth To Three Series** – 6 classes at 2 hours each on each of the 5 Domains of Development
3. **Health and Safety Series** – 4 classes at 2 hours each on Tummy Time, Outdoor play, Moving and Learning, and Mealtimes

Effective October 1, 2016 all child care PROVIDERS must be ELIGIBLE to receive child care subsidies. **PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY requires at least 10 hours of DFD Approved Health & Safety Training as well as Pediatric First Aid & CPR Training. These trainings are available online at no or low cost at [www.njccis.com](http://www.njccis.com) and [www.childcarenj.com](http://www.childcarenj.com) or in person through Child & Family Resources and all other Child Care Resource and Referral organizations in New Jersey.**

- NJ Health & Safety Basics (8 hours): includes Child Development (2 hours) & Health & Safety Basics (6 hours)
- Mandated Reporter/Child Abuse& Neglect (2 hours)

In-person:

- Health & Safety Basics (6 hours)
- Foundations of Child Development (2 hours)
- Identifying Child Abuse & Neglect (2 hours)

### **Pediatric Residency Program: Providing Community Child Care Health Education**

Through this collaboration Pediatric Residents are available to child care providers and the children and families in their care. Community Child Care Health Education *promotes healthy and safe environments, provides health and safety information, and encourages preventive health care for all children in child care.*

On-site visits are pre-arranged and require advance notification. Visits typically last about one hour.

What to expect during an on-site Pediatric Resident Visit: *Classroom Observation, Health & Safety Education, Program for teacher & children (A 10–15 minute developmentally and age appropriate activity presented by the Pediatric Resident, Exit briefing and Technical Assistance with program Director).*
