Effective October 1, 2016 all child care PROVIDERS must be ELIGIBLE to receive child care subsidies. ***PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY requires at least 10 hours of DFD Approved Health & Safety Training as well as Pediatric First Aid & CPR Training. Through this collaboration Pediatric Residents are available to child care providers and the children and families in their care. Community Child Care Health Education *promotes healthy and safe environments, provides health and safety information, encourages preventive health care for all children in child care.* On-site visits are pre-arranged and require advance notification. Visits typically last about one hour.
