Effective October 1, 2016 all child care PROVIDERS must be **ELIGIBLE** to receive child care subsidies. **PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY requires at least 10 hours of DFD Approved Health & Safety Training as well as Pediatric First Aid & CPR Training. These trainings are available online at no or low cost at [www.njccis.com](http://www.njccis.com) and [www.childcarenj.com](http://www.childcarenj.com) or in person through Child & Family Resources and all other Child Care Resource and Referral organizations in New Jersey.**

On-site visits are pre-arranged and require advance notification. Visits typically last about one hour.

What to expect during an on-site Pediatric Resident Visit: *Classroom Observation, Health & Safety Education, Program for teacher & children (A 10–15 minute developmentally and age appropriate activity presented by the Pediatric Resident, Exit briefing and Technical Assistance with program Director*
