### Pediatric Residency Program Child & Family

Resources' collaboration with the Pediatric Residency Program Goryeb Children's Hospital Atlantic Health and Pediatric & Adolescent Health Education programs helps fill the void left by the elimination of Child Care Health Consultation from the state budget. Through this collaboration Pediatric Residents are available to child care providers and the children and families in their care.

#### On-site visits:

These are pre-arranged and require advance notification. Visits typically last about one hour. The lessons are geared for ages 3 to 5 years old.
