Effective October 1, 2016 all child care PROVIDERS must be ELIGIBLE to receive child care subsidies. *PROVIDER ELIGIBILITY requires at least 10 hours of DFD Approved Health & Safety Training as well as Pediatric First Aid & CPR Training. These trainings are available online at no or low cost at www.njccis.com and www.childcarenj.com or in person through Child & Family Resources and all other Child Care Resource and Referral organizations in New Jersey.*
