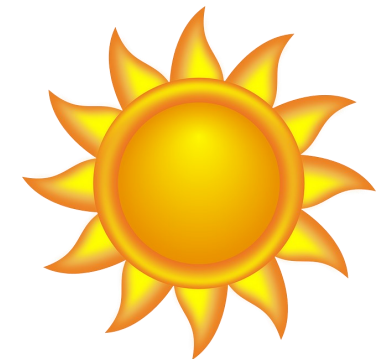

Child Care Resources & Referral (CCR&R): We engage and partner with parents, child care professionals, and the community to ensure that all families have access to a nurturing, motivating, and inspiring early care and education system for their children ages 6 weeks to 5 years. Child & Family Resources offers a multitude of CCR&R programs and services including the following:

## Services for Parents

- Referrals to local child care providers.
- Consumer Education: How to select a quality program for your child and family.
- Financial Assistance for eligible families.
- Access to community resources for children of varying abilities.
- Assistance with building a collaborative relationship with your caregiver.
- Workshops that build parenting skills.
- Certified Parent Coaching Sessions.
- Supervised Visitation Services

## Services for Child care Programs & Providers

- Family Child Care Provider Registration, Technical Assistance, & Training
- Assisting new child care providers with the start-up process
- Helping providers meet licensing requirements
- Offering low-cost or free trainings in topics like health and safety, child development, and sound business practices
- Working with local and state governments and the private sector to leverage resources for building and maintaining the supply of quality child care
- Providing ongoing professional development opportunities to child care providers and staff
- Supporting accreditation programs
- Advocating for better pay for providers
